#### **Athletic Director Job Description and Responsibilities**

### **Objective:**

The Athletic Director will oversee the daily operations of Gateway Christian Academy's athletic program, ensuring that all student-athletes, coaches, athletic staff, and game personnel uphold the school's mission and values. This position serves as a liaison between the middle school and high school directors and the Head of School, making key decisions that impact the athletic department.

In alignment with the FCA 3Dimensional Coaching Philosophy, the Athletic Director will lead a program that develops student-athletes physically, mentally, and spiritually while fostering a spirit of excellence in all aspects of competition and personal growth.

As Scripture reminds us in 1 Corinthians 9:24, "Run in such a way as to win the prize," we will strive for excellence in competition while honoring Christ in all we do.

## **Responsibilities:**

The following duties will be performed under the supervision of the Head of School:

## Physical Dimension (Fundamentals & Operations) - Competing with Excellence

- Oversee and manage the entire middle and high school athletics program.
- Hire, evaluate, and support coaches, ensuring alignment with the school's mission and
- Schedule athletic contests and confirm with opposing schools and officials.
- Arrange and coordinate transportation for games and practices when necessary.
- Ensure proper use, maintenance, and scheduling of athletic facilities.
- Oversee the athletic budget, including purchasing equipment, uniforms, and coaching resources.
- Organize game management personnel, including concessions, scorekeepers, and ticket sales.
- Work with local organizations (such as Parks and Recreation) for field and facility use.
- Ensure proper distribution, inventory, and maintenance of uniforms and equipment.
- Assist in athletic field/gymnasium preparation for games and practices.

## Mental Dimension (Mindset & Development) – Training with Excellence

- Mentor and develop coaches in leadership, team-building, and professional growth.
- Promote athletics to students and families, encouraging participation and engagement.
- Organize and oversee student recognition events such as end-of-season banquets and awards nights.
- Communicate effectively with parents, faculty, staff, boosters, and alumni regarding athletic department updates.
- Support and coordinate student-athlete leadership and discipleship programs.
- Oversee and assist with intramural programs to promote broader student participation.
- Ensure that students and coaches are informed of game changes, cancellations, and practice adjustments in a timely manner.

## Spiritual Dimension (Heart & Purpose) – Competing for Christ

- Lead the athletic program in alignment with Gateway Christian Academy's mission to impact students for Christ.
- Ensure that all coaches integrate biblical principles into their leadership and interactions with student-athletes.
