Position Overview

The ideal candidate will be a committed Christian who integrates faith and biblical principles into coaching, fostering spiritual growth, character development, and athletic excellence.

This part-time position requires a leader who can inspire student-athletes to excel on the court while upholding the school's mission.

Gateway Christian Academy competes in the Metro Conference and is a part of the VISAA.

Key Responsibilities

- Team Leadership and Development: Plan and conduct practices, develop game strategies, and coach games to improve players' skills, teamwork, and competitive performance.
- Spiritual Mentorship: Integrate Christian values into coaching by modeling Christlike character and fostering a team culture rooted in faith, respect, and integrity.
- Player Development: Provide individualized feedback to help student-athletes grow in their basketball skills, physical fitness, and personal discipline.
- Program Management: Oversee team logistics, including scheduling, equipment management, and communication with parents, school administration, and athletic directors.
- Community Engagement: Represent the school positively in the community, at games, and in interactions with opposing teams, officials, and spectators.
- Safety and Compliance: Ensure the safety of student-athletes during practices and games, adhering to school policies, league regulations, and safety protocols.
- Collaboration: Work closely with school administration, faculty, and parents to support the holistic development of student-athletes.

Qualifications:

- Faith Commitment: A professing Christian with a strong personal faith, actively involved in a local church, and committed to the school's statement of faith.
- Coaching Experience: Previous coaching experience in basketball (high school level preferred) or significant playing experience with a desire to transition into coaching.

- Knowledge of Basketball: Understanding basketball fundamentals, strategies, and training techniques. Must be able to create age and skill level appropriate practice plans. Leadership Skills: Ability to motivate, inspire, and discipline student-athletes while fostering a positive and encouraging team environment.
- Communication: Mus possess interpersonal and communication skills to engage students, parents and school staff as needed.
- Education: High school diploma required; bachelor's degree preferred. Relevant certifications (e.g., CPR, First Aid, or coaching certifications) are a plus.
- Background Check: Must pass a criminal background check and adhere to the school's code of conduct.

Working Conditions

- Schedule: Part-time, seasonal position with practices and games typically occurring in the afternoons, evenings, and occasional weekends during the basketball season (November–March).
- Environment: Work primarily takes place in the school gymnasium, with travel required for away games.
- Compensation: Stipend based on experience and qualifications, to be discussed during the interview process.
